Water Bottle Filling Stations: Through a partnership with local schools, water bottle filling stations have been installed for all students. The program is currently expanding to local public buildings and private businesses.

Community Gardens: Fairfield Forward collaborates with local organizations to install community gardens. The gardens allow all citizens in the community to enjoy the mental and physical benefits of gardening.

Kids in Parks: Based in downtown Winnsboro, this effort allows our younger generations the joy of experiencing their own historical walking tour for exercise!
